In-House Skill Development Programs

The contemporary world is characterized by increased globalization and competition. Due to this it presents a lot of challenges which can be overwhelming for many people especially the youth. With this aim, Daulat Ram College envisioned and initiated In-House Skill Development Programs for its students so as to equip them with various key skills in 2015. 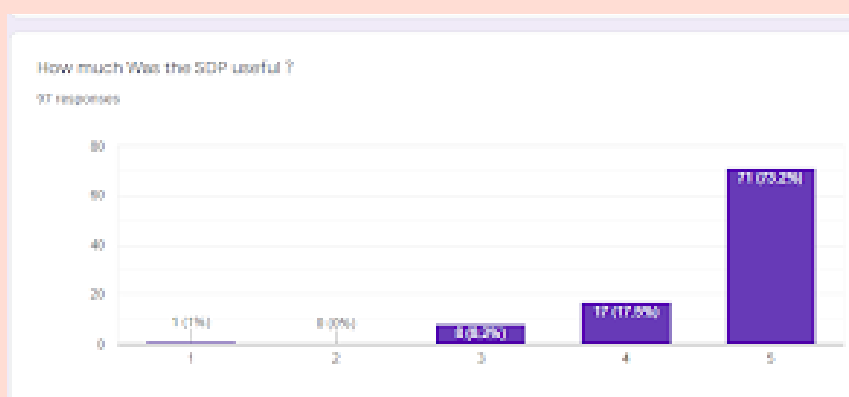

SDP feedback on Google form was invited from student participants and 76 students submitted the form.

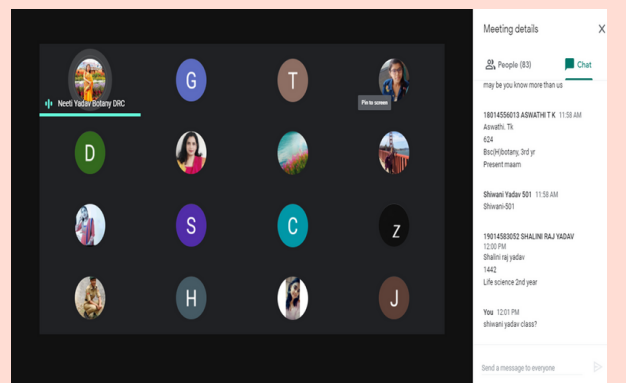
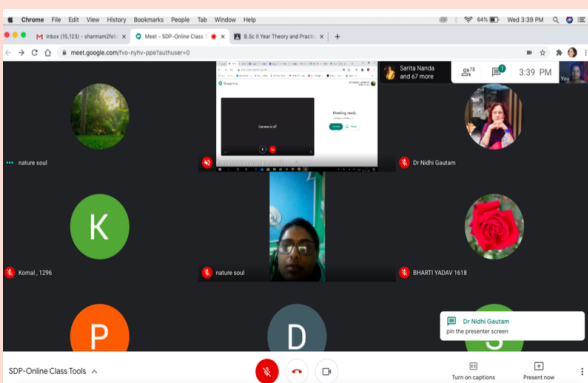
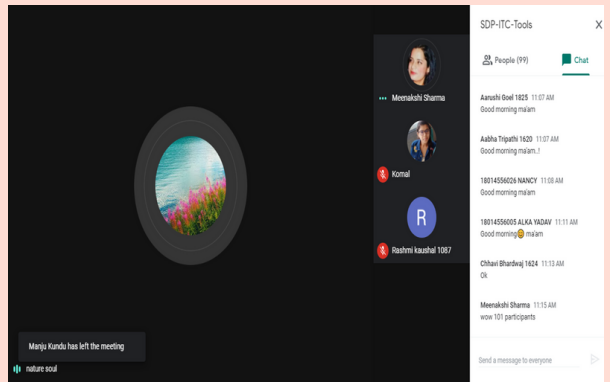
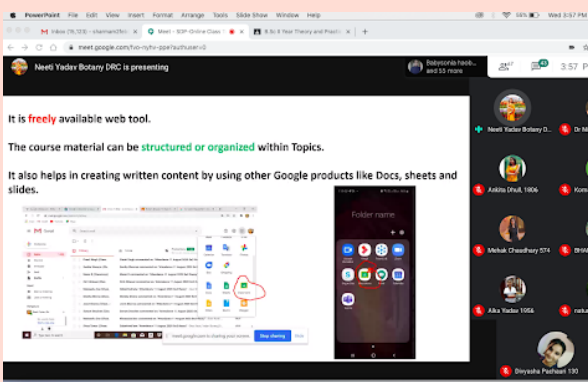
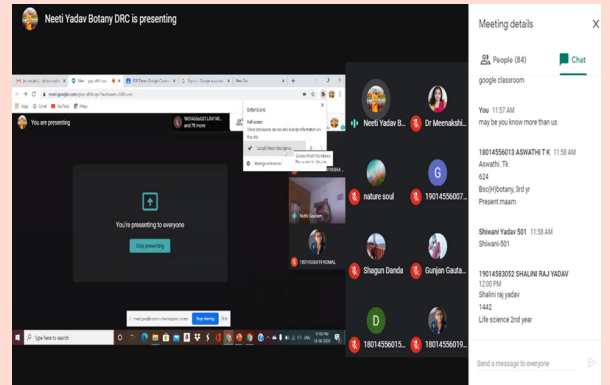
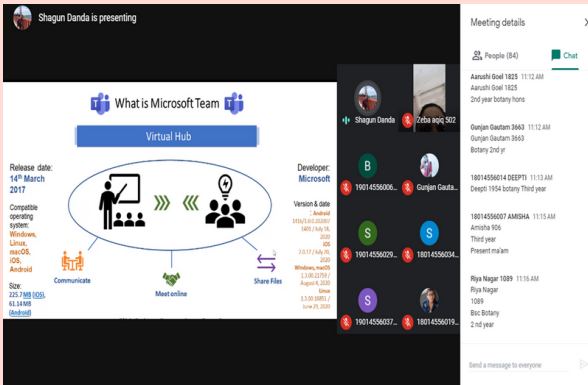

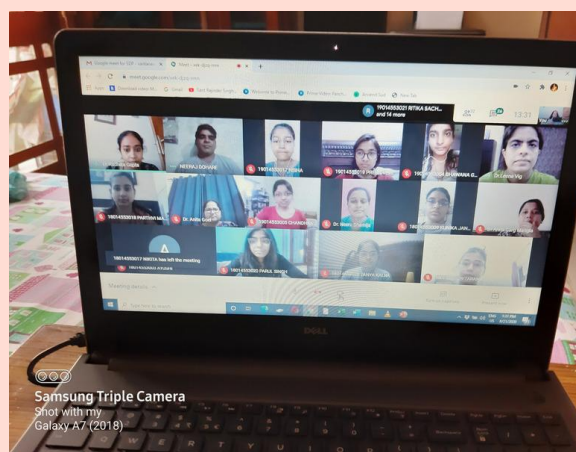
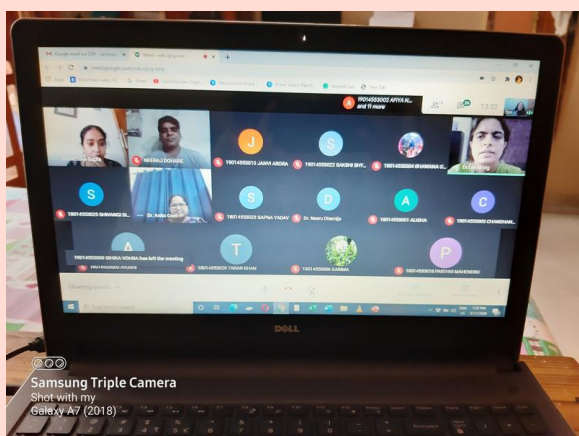
Feedback of Participants:

All the students from semester III and semester V attended the SDP. 61% students found the SDP very relevant and 50% were very satisfied by the course content. More than 90% students agreed that all their queries were satisfied by the resource persons.

In the individual sessions, Google Docs and Google Sheets was found most relevant by 36 students, plagiarism was found to be most relevant by 32 students, followed by Google Forms (29 students) and Google Suite (28 students). And lastly, 22 students found Google Scholar very relevant.

65% students would like to have such SDPs again. Most of the students did not provide any suggestion. One of the major suggestions was to introduce Android phone-based learning as many students do not have laptop.

On the first day, 51 students were present and 44 have submitted the feedback form. All of them found the session very interesting and useful.

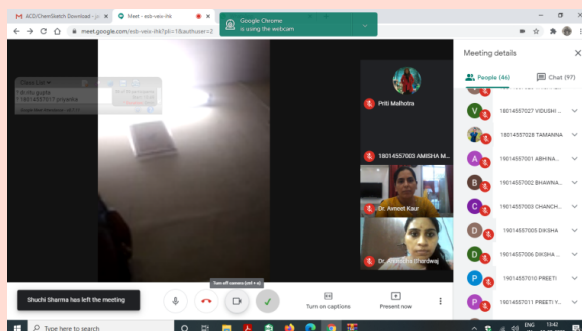
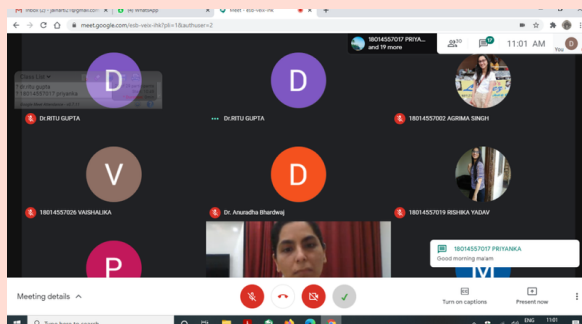
On the second day, 51 students attended the session 44 students have submitted the feedback form .All of them found the session very informative.

About E-SDP: The Commerce Department, Daulat Ram College organized ICT tool training on the topic entitled “ **Simplifying Online Learning Through ICT Tools: Bridging the Virtual & the Physical Gap**” for its students under the massive intra college drive from 17th to 19th August in morning and evening sessions of two hours each for 3rd year and 2nd-year students under the the leadership of Ma'am Principal, Dr Savita Roy and TIC Commerce Dept., Mrs Sushma Arora with in-house faculty members as resource persons. Dr Gurmeet Kaur, Dr Sunita, Dr Gunjan Gupta and Ms Megha Jain, Ms Roopshikha, Ms Preeti Singh, Dr Isha Goel & Mrs Richa Kaur were the Resource Persons for this 3 Day E-SDP.

Key Objectives of 3-Day E-SDP:

- To assist the students in the transition of physical classroom learning to online classroom learning.
- To familiarize students primarily with the online teaching-learning platforms such as Google Classroom and Google Meet.
- To provide training to the students regarding creation & submission of numerical and computer-based papers
- To provide hands-on exposure to the students regarding creation & submission of assignments and also for creation of PowerPoint presentation.

COMMERCE DEPARTMENT

The sessions conducted covered the extensive usage of technology to enable students to attend to their classes smoothly via systems and mobiles too using virtual platforms like Google Classroom, Google Meet etc. The sessions remained a huge success in reaching out each one of them to make them comfortable and convenient using technology tools. The no. of participants exceeded 450 that remained glued to the session till the end. The one-to-one feedback by many of them confirmed the success of the entire session and program too.

Method of Assessment:

A Quiz assignment was given to the students to assess their learning outcomes from 3Day E-SDP and a total of 366 students attempted & submitted the Quiz Assignment.

Of these:

86% of the respondents have scored 7 or more marks.

75% have scored 8 or more marks.

51% have scored 9 or more marks.

27% of the respondents scored full marks (10/10)

Average score: 8.28/10

Median score: 9/10

Feedback Compilation & Analysis:

A well designed feedback form was circulated among the students and they were asked to submit on mandatory basis. All the students were extremely satisfied with the SDP content and speakers also. This SDP has boosted student's confidence to attend online classes. They all found the sessions very enriching & insightful and it has enhanced their knowledge on modern learning tools.

There were 8 resource persons in both the session for all 3 days. All students are very much satisfied with the content delivered by resource persons. Graphical data analysis about the event showed that all students were fully satisfied with every aspects of the event like Usefulness of session, Quality of Speakers/Resource Persons, Content of SDP, knowledge gained after attending the SDP, Registration Process. Students were asked to give suggestions regarding conduct of more such events in future & 90% of the students showed their interest in attending more of such types of events in future.

Name of Program: In-House Skill Development Program, ICT Tools for Online Learning. Under IQAC, by the Economics Department, Daulat Ram College, University of Delhi

Objectives: Information and Communications Technology (ICT) use in the classroom is important for giving students opportunities to learn and apply the required 21st century skills. More so, in these times of pandemic, with online classes as the new norm, it becomes imperative to equip the teachers and students with these tools. In order to do so, we need to recognize the issues and challenges related to ICT usage in teaching and learning.

Understanding this, the main purpose of the present program is to perceive and analyze the challenges faced in using ICT tools in classrooms by students and teachers and train them with these tools while overcoming these challenges.

Duration with Dates: 3 Days: 17th to 19th August 2020 from 11:00AM to 1:00PM daily.

Number and Profile of Participants: 204 students of Daulat Ram College, from BA(H) Economics (183 students) and BA(P) (Economics + Maths) (21students) course attended the program.

Method of Assessment of the Participants: After discussion on google meet and classroom on Day 1, the students were asked to join SDP Google Classroom. In the classroom they were asked to submit answers to questions, pop quiz and assignment by filling google form shared by the resource person; attaching files- word, excel or PowerPoint and by sharing google files created by them.

The aim was to encourage them to utilize their new understanding of google files and MS office, to attempt fulfillment of assessment assigned on google classroom platform.

The assessment was analyzed to highlight the challenges that students may face and point to the common mistakes made by them during submission of the answers. This was a continuous 3 days exercise.

Apart from above, Day 2 and 3 discussions concluded by providing practice exercises on the days' topics.

To assess the feedback, following questions were asked:

Q1. How Useful were the practice exercises being conducted during the SDP?
Options: Useful, Very useful and not useful. Of the feedback received, 51% found the exercises conducted as part of assessment in SDP to be 'very useful' and the remaining 49% found them 'useful'.

Q2. How was your experience related to the resource persons of the program?

ECONOMICS DEPARTMENT

Options: Excellent, Satisfactory, Average and Poor.

Of the feedback received, 53.65% found the experience related to the resource persons of the program to be 'excellent', 46.34% found it 'satisfactory', 0% found it 'average' and 0% reported it to be 'poor'.

Q3. How was overall experience? Options: Excellent, Satisfactory, Average and Poor. Of the feedback received, 36.58% found the overall experience related to the program to be 'excellent', 51.22% found it 'satisfactory', 9.75% found it 'average' and 0% reported it to be 'poor'.

Q4. Are more SDPs such as these welcome? Options: Yes and No. Of the feedback received, 95% are open to more SDPs like these.

Introduction, Demonstration over Google Meet using shared screens (participant's doubts were clarified after each segment), Google Docs/Sheet, Google Drive, Navigating GSuite (including sign-in procedures etc), Google Classroom, Creating tutorial work and uploading assignments from computers and smartphones, Intensive session where more questions were answered and the aforementioned applications were explored again as per the needs of the students. Assignment topic was shared with the participants and they were expected to: Join a Classroom, Upload their assignment document within the stipulated deadline. Concluding messages from the Course Coordinator and Resources Persons, and Faculty Facilitators

Day 3 with 2nd and 3rd Honors:

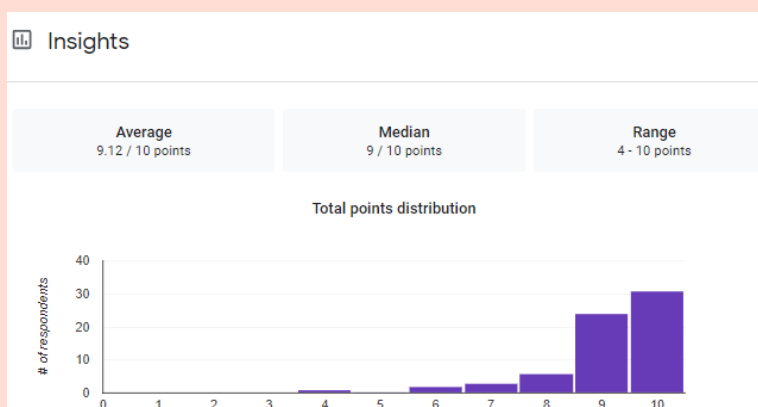
On Day 3 the following schedule was followed: Doubts and queries were resolved through demonstrations once again. Questions raised over the previous two days were explored. The students' suggestions and concerns submitted through the SDP Feedback form were considered and addressed. (More has been done on this front since Wednesday, the 19th of August.) Their assignments were discussed in case there were issues with their submissions. A quiz was assigned to test the participants' knowledge of what had been discussed thoroughly over the three days. Concluding remarks from teachers and students.

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Method of Assessments of Participants:

The participants were given the following tasks:

1. They were given an assignment which they were supposed to upload on the designated Classroom using their institutional ids. Faculty Facilitators and Resource Persons responded to each and every assignment individually and graded them.
2. The students attempted a quiz after the conclusion of the SDP and we are glad to report that they did exceedingly well, with the class average being 9.2/10.

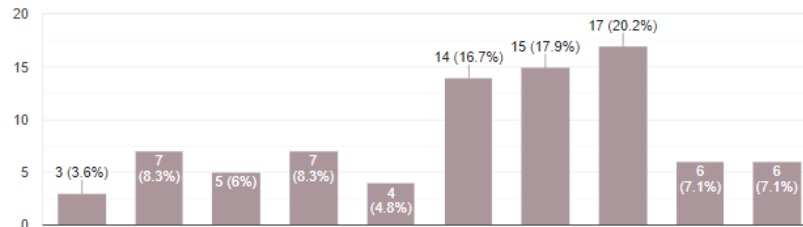
ENGLISH DEPARTMENT

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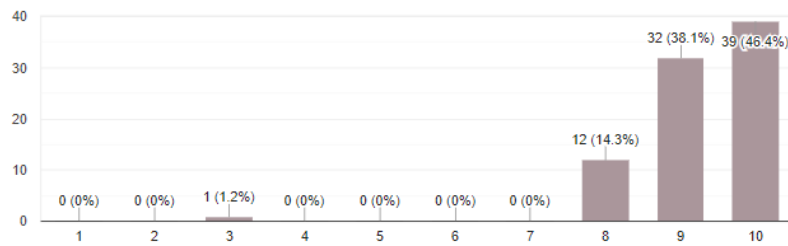
What was your level of familiarity with GSuite before this SDP?

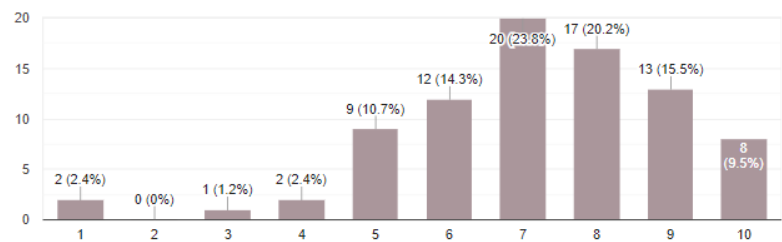
What is your level of familiarity with GSuite after this SDP?

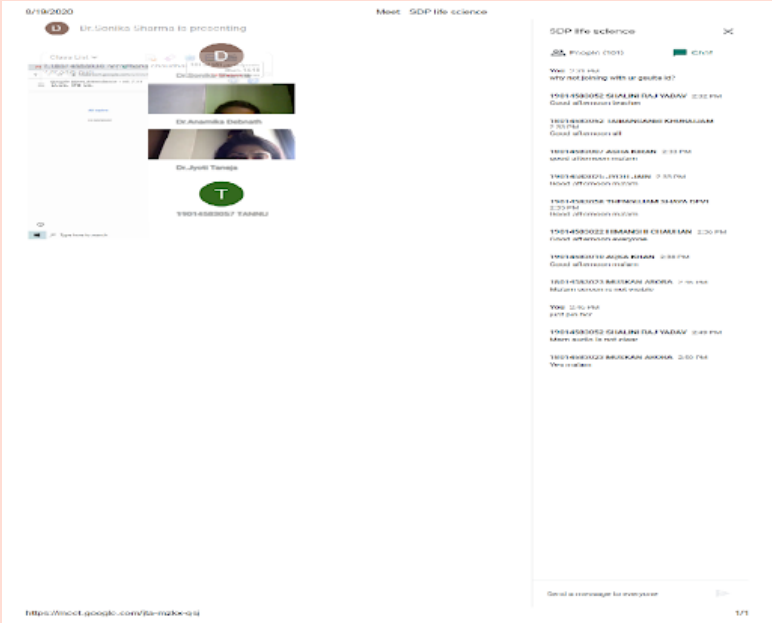
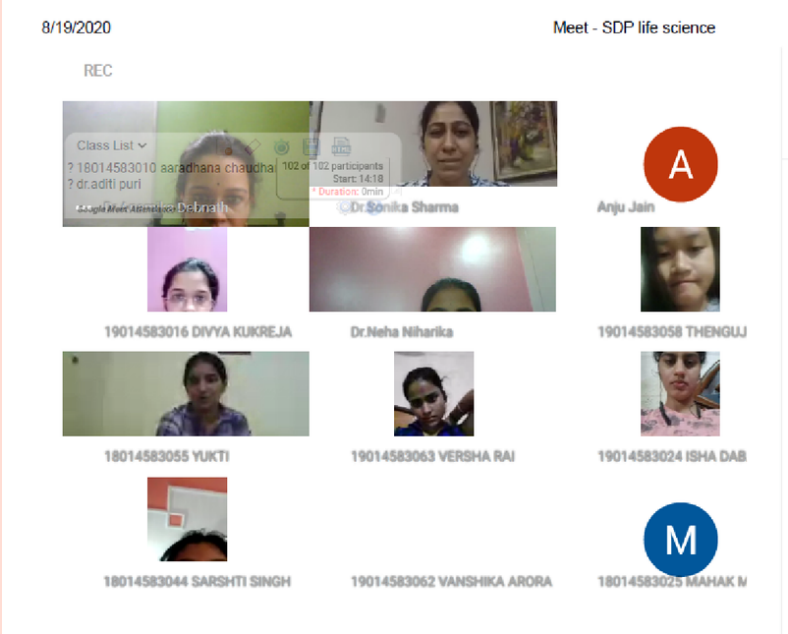
Feedback from Participants Regarding the Event:

The first day of the program was duly initiated by the Vedic Manglacharan by Bhavana. Dr. Savita Roy, Principal, Daulat Ram College, Mr. Manish Kumar, CEO & MD, National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Dr. Pooja V. Anand, SDP Convenor gave their best wishes for the students through a video message. Dr. Sharda Gautam bid the welcome and gave a brief description about the 3-day program. Dr. Deepti Bansal from the Music Department and Dr. Shashi Sharma from the Sanskrit Department gave their blessings to the students. Also Dr. Sushma Devi congratulated everyone for the program. The first session started with the significant discussion on the topic 'various online learning methods and need of online tools available for learning' by Dr. Saurabh Ji. He explained how MS-Word can be used for multiple purposes like creating and designing documents etc. Then he guided the students about Microsoft PowerPoints, Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Teams and Google Classroom. After that, the second speaker was Mr. Ravi Meena, who introduced Microsoft word & language software. He also told everyone about the uses of Microsoft office as a family of client software, server software, and other services.

Then he briefed about the basic parts of MS-Word including undo-redo, find and replace, header and footer, words art and spell check. The session was completed with a kalyan mantra done by Shradha Aggrawal.

On the second day of the program, the first session was on Google Apps, Documents, Classroom and Meet by Dr. Saurabh Ji. He briefly explained about all the tools of Google Classroom, how to create a class, how to submit assignments etc. The second speaker, Mr. Ravi Meena explained to the students about the uses of MS-Excel and its features in online learning. Also he introduced Microsoft Office, Excel, Worksheet, Workbook and other tools.

On the third day of the program, the first session was conducted on how to use Microsoft Teams for online learning by Dr. Saurabh Ji. He explained about the usage and functions of Microsoft Teams and how it can be efficiently used by teachers and students in online learning. The second speaker, Mr. Ravi Meena explained to the students about Microsoft PowerPoint and its basic features like creation of slides, presentation making, slide deck etc.

On all the three days, after the end of the session, the queries of the students were answered by the respective resource person. The anchoring of the program was done by Neha Beniwal & Shweta Sharma and the link was hosted by Muskan Gulati. 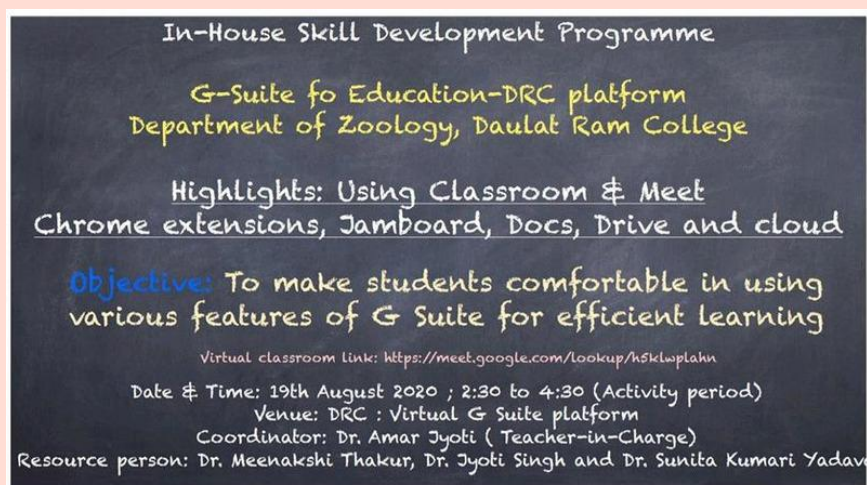

Hence, the College is organizing In-House Skill Development Program on 'Enhancing Learning through ICT Tools' for all its students from 17th to August, 2020. ZOOLOGY DEPARTMENT



Name of Event and Organizing Department: Faculties of the Zoology Department conducted in-house Skill Development Program for Zoology Honours.

Date and Duration: Students on 19th August 2020 from 2:30 to 4:30 pm during activity period were introduced with with Google platform for education.

Objectives: Students were properly introduced with Google platform for education. Although our students were using Google classroom and meet for online classes, they were not confident and aware in a proper way. Therefore our main objective was to make them comfortable with it.

Program Schedule:

Session was started by Dr. Amar Jyoti with an introduction and benefits of using Google suite platform for teaching and learning during Covid-19 crisis. Students were explained the significance and the privacy policies of G Suite username and password provided by the college. During the entire session, through videos, demonstrations and interactive features of Google Meet were explained. They initially learnt how to create google classroom, schedule google meetings through Google calendar and present their screen using either android mobile or desktop. As a classroom extension, students also learnt to create and respond to Google forms and announcements. Students and teachers interacted on live Jamboard and learnt the benefits of the same.

Students were also introduced to various Chrome extensions that are available on chrome web store. They have learnt how to download and use chrome extensions for google classroom.

Our students learned features of screen recording, google calendar scheduling, and small PDF extensions which can convert any file into pdf with one click. A demo of thirteen different types of useful chrome extension was given to our students. The purpose of this exercise was to make them aware about online assessment. They were informed that with time stamped submission and integrated attendance record continuous assessment will be extremely transparent. All regular students will have advantage in securing good grades if they attend classes and submit grades on time.

Students were explained the benefits of using an official email ID and its security features. Towards the end of the first session students were felt confident in using the Google Suite platform.

In the second session, Dr. Sunita Yadav has described unique features of Google sheet and slides. She explained how to use Excel or Google sheet for making relevant graphs for a given data. Dr. Sunita has also briefly described significance of using formulas to perform complex calculations as well as statistics. This was an important session since our students will be using these software for experimental write-up and making projects which are currently a part of curriculum.

In the third session Dr. Jyoti Singh explained to students how to use Google documents (docs). She showed various features of Google doc and gave demonstration of voice typing features for preparing assignments. Dr. Jyoti also explained methods for downloading and using add-on features available for Google doc & sheet. Explanations about the similarity of Google doc and Microsoft Word was also explained to them. She described students how to share documents through drive and perform simultaneous editing.

To summarize, a lot of topics were covered during these two hours, keeping in mind that students should comfortably attend online classes on Google meet and classroom. They should utilize Google docs, Sheets, Slides and form features for making assignments and projects. Emphasis was given on making them aware of using Institutional email ID for official communication and utilizing Jamboard as well as whiteboard for group discussions and brainstorming. Overall both students and teachers enjoyed this interactive session.
