

## **IQAC convenor Report - 2025-26**

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Daulat Ram College works with the vision and mission of planning, guiding, monitoring Quality Assurance (QA) and Quality Enhancement (QE) activities of the College. The IQAC works with the aim to channelize and systematize all efforts of the institution towards academic excellence.

The IQAC continuously strives for academic excellence, improvement of sustainable infrastructure, facilities and scholastic environment for students to excel and achieve their goals.

It was a matter of great accomplishment that Daulat ram college achieved a Big Leap in **NIRF ranking from 72 to 26.**

With the aim to achieve the target of “**One College one Data**”, and adopt a systematic data management system, the college had implemented the ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning) student related modules including, attendance, AEC/ GE/ VAC/ SEC courses allotment, internal Assessment (IA) and time-tables, from the session 2024-25. In 2025-26, the college also made the faculty related Data modules functional on the ERP. This would enable proper assessment of academic progress and smoothen the process of navigating different Ranking systems.

The 4th year undergraduate Research track guidelines were successfully implemented in the college. The **Research Committee of College (RCC)** was put in place. For smooth implementation, in each department, a Subject Research Committee (**SRC**) was set up and each student was under the mentorship of Advisory Committee for Research (**ACR**) consisting of a student supervisor and additional two members.

IQAC organized a Capacity Building workshop on **CCS Conduct rules and Disciplinary measures** by Mr. Virendra Kumar, Joint Registrar, School of Planning and Architecture, Delhi, was organized on 4 th July, 2025 for the Non- teaching Staff of Daulat Ram College. Principal Prof. Savita Roy, IQAC convenor, Prof. Padmshree Mudgal, Chief Librarian, Mr. Pawan Tripathi, AO (Admin), Ms. Vijeta

Rana, AO (Accounts), Mr. Atul Bhaskar and 60 nonteaching staff attended the session. Mr. Virendra Kumar, very lucidly with interesting anecdotes, made a very heavy and difficult topic of Disciplinary measures simple to understand and grasp. The Non-teaching staff really gained from the session.

IQAC members attended a workshop titled “**Empowering College IQACs to Uphold Research Integrity: Addressing the Challenge of Predatory and Cloned Journals**” organized by IQAC, University of Delhi, on Nov. 13, 2025. A talk on “**Tools to identify cloned and predatory journals and, why is it important?**” by IQAC convenor Prof. Padmshree Mudgal was organized for the teaching faculty of DRC on 9th Dec. 2025, to guide faculty members to publish in high impact journals.

The IQAC completed the screening process for the promotion of faculty members at the various levels of promotion.

To promote Research environment and collaborative interactions in the college, the College launched the second round **DRC Navdhara Research grants** in 2024. The second installment of grants to 15 projects, 2 from the humanities, 2 from Commerce and economics and 11 from the science stream were released in 2025-26.

The College received an additional grant of Rs. 15 lakhs from Skill enhancement Courses committee, Delhi University for establishing new **Skill Development Centers** and upgrading the established Skill Development centers. The College is setting up a New Skill Development center of Medical Diagnostics.

The College also initiated many new extensions and community outreach activities. The College in collaboration with **Ekal foundation** organized a 4 day fun and learning camp: ”Bhavishya kee aur ek Udaam”.for 30 children of Allipur village, Faridabad. The College has adopted 5 villages in Faridabad under **Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan** for community outreach activities.

The IQAC would continue its endeavor for scholastic excellence following the best practices.
