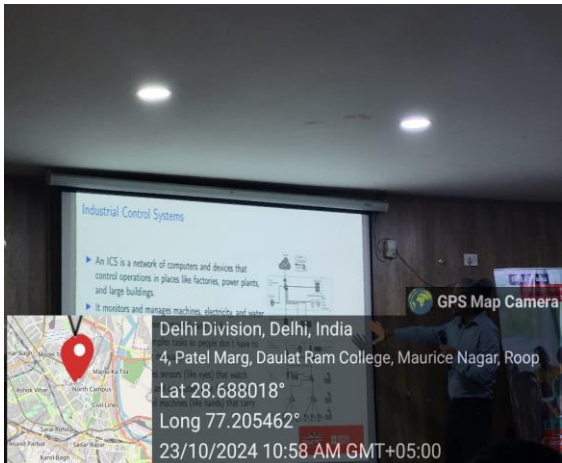

Caseneur – The Case Competition
