OBJECTIVES	The objective was to explore the dynamic architectural transformations that took place in Delhi and its surrounding regions over six centuries. The primary objective was to trace the evolution of medieval architecture in North India by examining how different cultural, political, and artistic influences—particularly from Central Asia and indigenous Indian traditions—merged to create a unique architectural vocabulary.

METHODOLOGY	The speaker combined historical narrative with visual documentation, using photographs, maps, and architectural drawings to illustrate key monuments and styles across different dynasties. The seminar also encouraged audience interaction, fostering a deeper understanding of Delhi's architectural heritage through comparative and interdisciplinary analysis.

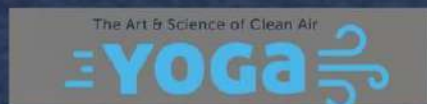

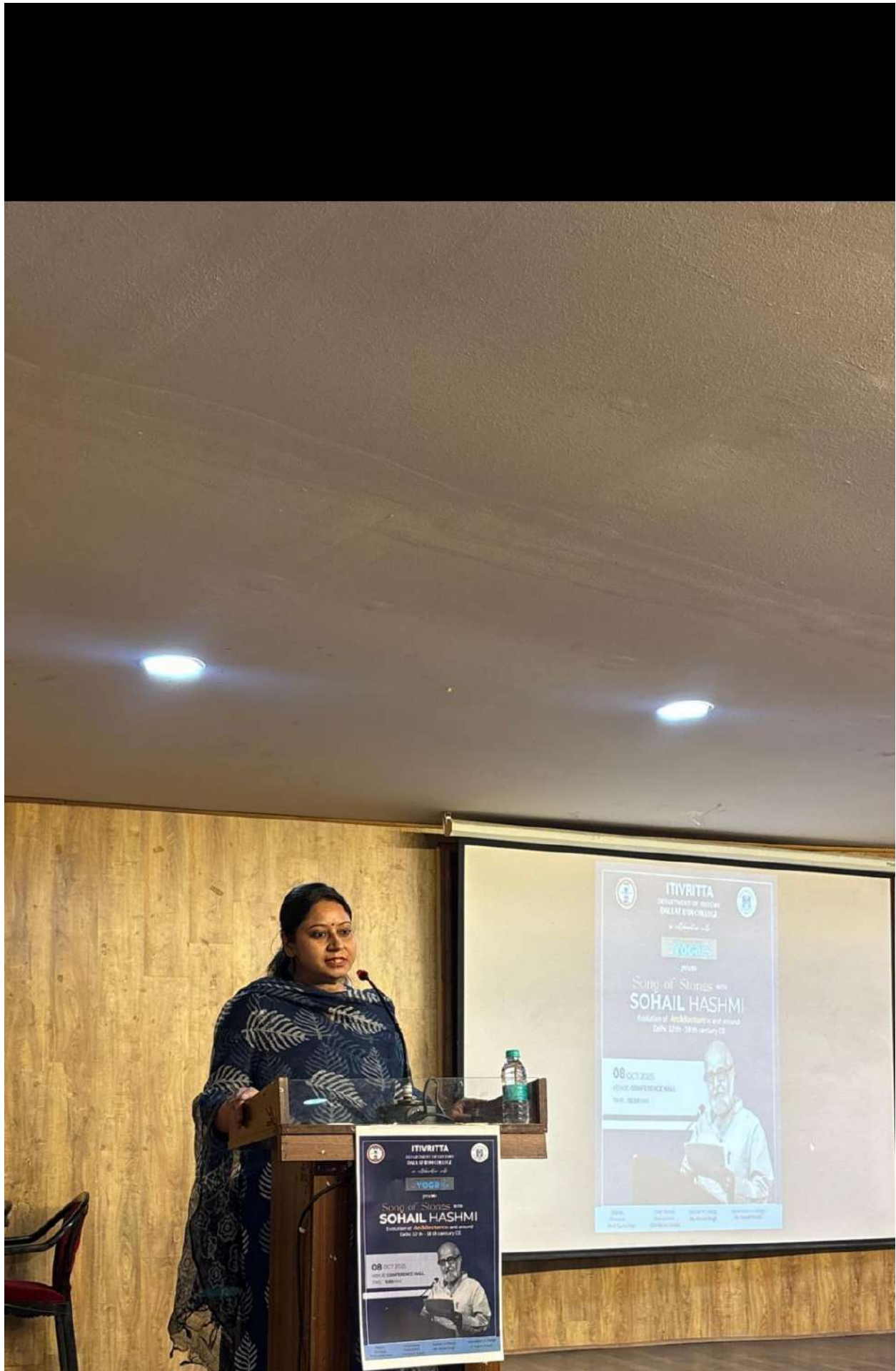

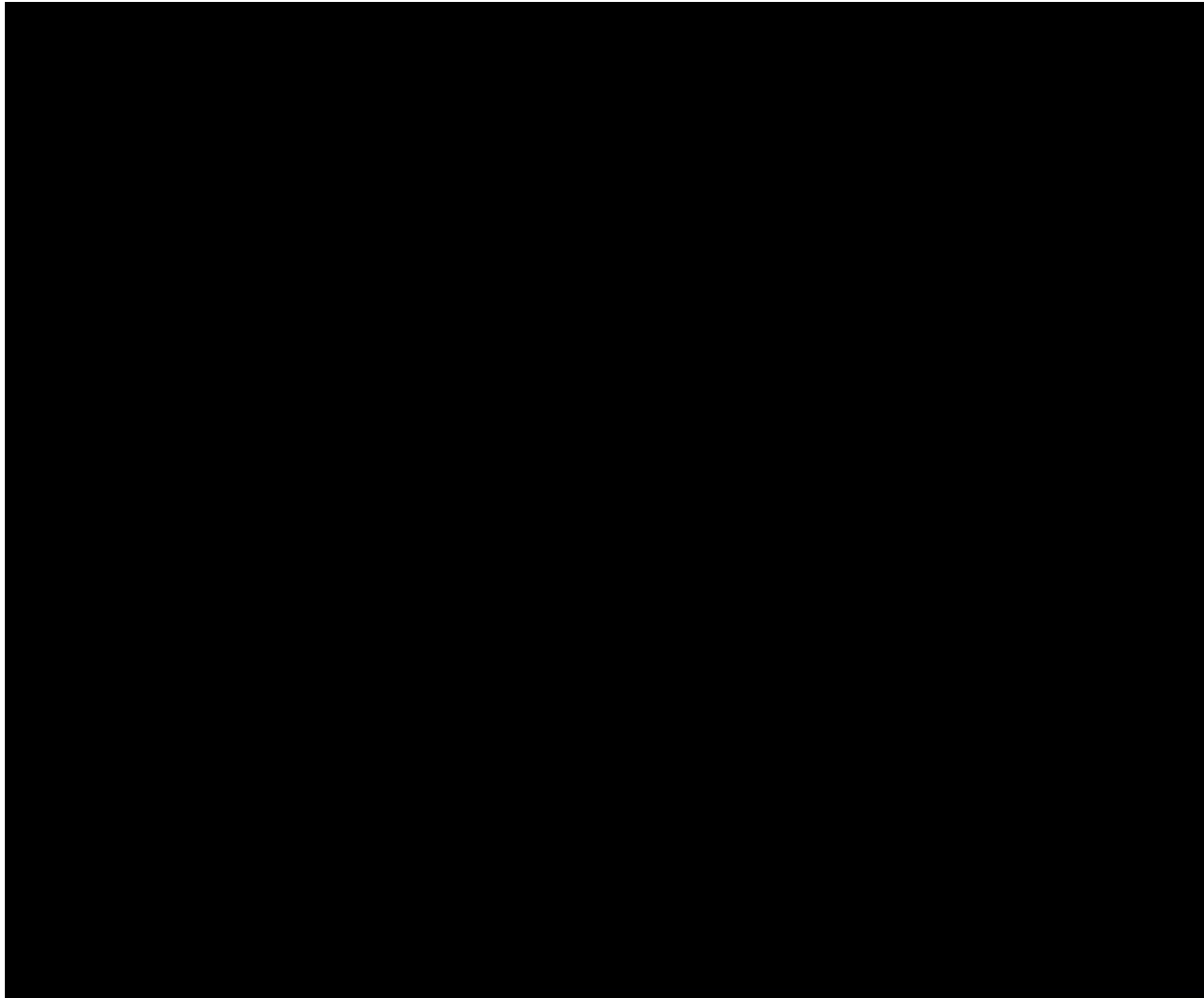

EVENT SUMMARY

Name of the event: Song of Stones

with Sohail Hashmi

Date: 08th October, 2025

The Department of History, Daulat Ram College, organized a special lecture titled "Song of Stones with Sohail Hashmi" on 8th October 2025. The central theme of the event was "The Evolution of Architecture in Delhi from the 12th to the 18th Century." The keynote speaker for the session was the renowned historian and storyteller, Sohail Hashmi. Known for his engaging and interactive style, Hashmi sir vividly brought to life the architectural journey of Delhi.

In his talk, he presented the historical layers of architecture through monuments, mosques, tombs, and forts — using examples such as clay pots, the lotus, kalash (sacred pitcher), swastika, and the dome. He explained how these elements evolved and became part of architectural expressions over time. Hashmi particularly emphasized how the kalash and swastika are often associated with Hinduism, and domes with Islam, yet these are universal cosmic symbols, not bound to any one religion. He strongly objected to linking architectural styles strictly with particular religions and elaborated in detail on how such elements reflect natural beauty and cosmic design beyond religious boundaries.

Students participated with great enthusiasm and actively engaged in the Q&A session at the end. The program proved to be highly informative and inspiring, deepening the students' interest in the architectural and historical legacy of Delhi.

The program was conducted under the guidance of the esteemed Teacher in charge of the history department, Ms. Menaka Singh. The event's structure and planning were overseen by Dr. Rajesh Prasad, the respected Association in charge of the history dept. The honoured college principal, Prof. Savita Roy, attended as the patron of the event.

The visit aimed to connect theoretical classroom learning with practical observation of monuments, museums, and regional traditions.

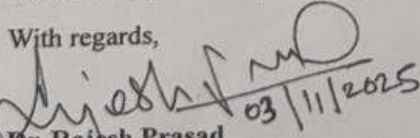

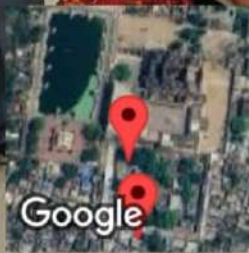

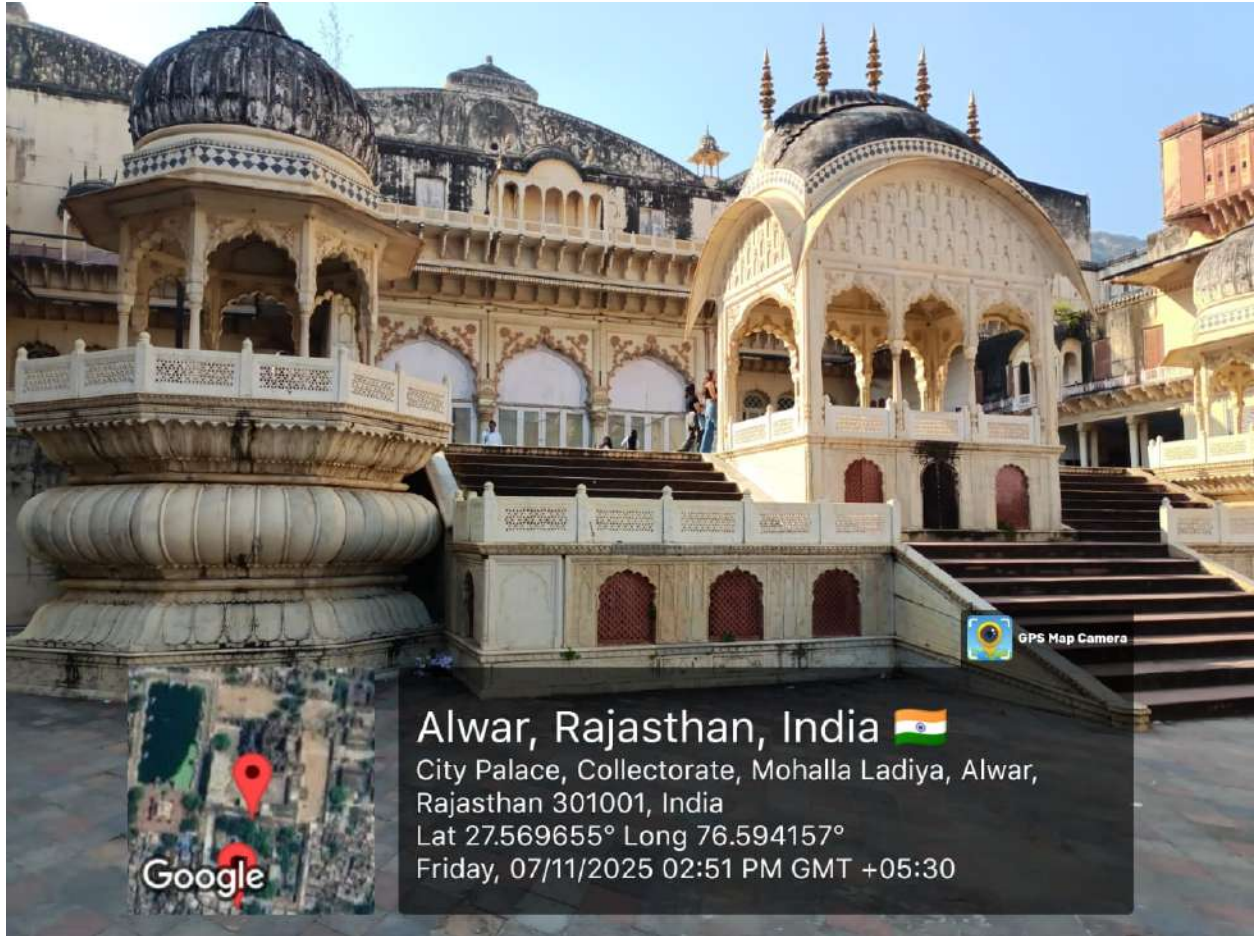

The serene atmosphere and intricate artistry of the site left everyone deeply impressed.

अलवर पहुँचने पर सबसे पहले हमने सिटी पैलेस का भ्रमण किया। अलवर का सिटी पैलेस 18वीं शताब्दी में महाराजा विनय सिंह द्वारा बनवाया गया था। यह राजस्थानी और मुगल स्थापत्य शैली का सुंदर मिश्रण है। विशाल प्रांगण, नक्काशीदार दरवाज़े और संगमरमर की नाजूक कारीगरी इसे अलवर की प्रमुख ऐतिहासिक धरोहर बनाते हैं। महल के भीतर स्थित संग्रहालय में हमने शाही परिवार से जुड़ी वस्तुएँ, प्राचीन मूर्तियाँ, हथियार, चित्रकला और ऐतिहासिक दस्तावेज़ देखे, जिन्होंने अलवर के इतिहास को जीवंत कर दिया।

सिटी पैलेस के बाद हमने मूसी महारानी की छतरी का अवलोकन किया। यह छतरी राजस्थान की स्थापत्य कला का सुंदर उदाहरण है। यह स्मारक महाराजा बख्तावर सिंह और उनकी रानी, रानी मूसी की स्मृति में बनाया गया था। यह स्मारक अपनी अद्वितीय नक्काशी, भव्य गुम्बदों और सजीले स्तंभों के लिए प्रसिद्ध है तथा राजस्थानी स्थापत्य कला की उत्कृष्टता का एक सुंदर उदाहरण प्रस्तुत करता है। इस स्थल की शांति और कलात्मक सौंदर्य ने सभी को प्रभावित किया। अलवर की इस यात्रा ने छात्राओं को ऐतिहासिक स्थलों के प्रत्यक्ष अध्ययन का अवसर प्रदान किया। पुस्तकों में पढ़े गए विषयों को वास्तविक रूप में देखकर इतिहास की समझ और गहरी हुई। साथ ही, इसने राजस्थान की सांस्कृतिक विरासत के प्रति सम्मान और जिज्ञासा को भी प्रोत्साहित किया।
