

EVENT SUMMARY

DRCMUN'24

The Daulat Ram College Model United Nations (MUN), held on November 16, 2024, was a vibrant and engaging platform for students to discuss pressing global and national issues. The event commenced with an inspiring opening ceremony organized by Éclat, the economics association of DRC, alongside Yuva Manthan Model United Nations. The ceremony set a collaborative tone, featuring a warm welcome to distinguished guests, faculty members, and delegates. Notable highlights included a ceremonial lamp lighting by honored guests, symbolizing the pursuit of wisdom, and keynote speeches from esteemed speakers, Mr. Dinendra Kashyap and Dr. Shankar Kumar, who inspired delegates to maximize their learning opportunities. Members of the Éclat Economic Association were recognized for their dedication and contributions, fostering academic and extracurricular excellence.

The UNGA committee focused on the theme "Achieving Carbon Neutrality by 2050: Innovative Policies for a Sustainable Future."
