EVENT SUMMARY

Niti Gupshup - Policy Discussion Forum

Eclat, the Economics Association of Daulat Ram College, successfully organized *Niti Gupshup*, a policy discussion forum, in the college sports ground. The event brought together students from diverse academic backgrounds for an engaging and insightful discussion on the theme: "**Balancing Global Integration and Local Self-Sufficiency: A Swadeshi Perspective.**"

The discussion explored the evolution of the *Swadeshi* movement, highlighting how its essence has transformed over the years. Students reflected on how, from being a nationalist economic strategy during the independence struggle, *Swadeshi* has now taken on a broader dimension—one that aligns with India's ambition to establish itself as a global economic superpower. While the methods and policies have evolved, the underlying idea of strengthening domestic industries and achieving self-reliance remains central to India's growth narrative.

Key topics covered included consumer choice, trade balance, and the readiness of Indian firms for global exports. Participants examined how changes in central leadership influence India's trade policies and economic positioning. They also brought in comparative models, citing examples of countries like China and South Korea, which have successfully integrated into global markets while maintaining a strong domestic industrial base.

A crucial segment of the discussion delved into policy frameworks, particularly the allocation of the national budget and the underutilization of research and development in India. Students debated how targeted investments in innovation and industrial expansion could enhance India's competitiveness on the global stage.

The discussion was marked by its high level of professionalism and intellectual depth, leading to a well-rounded understanding of public policy and economic strategies from a *Swadeshi* lens. The event proved to be a valuable platform for fostering critical analysis and policy-oriented thinking, reinforcing the importance of a balanced approach between global integration and local self-sufficiency.
